FAITHFUL LIVING IN FALTERING TIMES | THE LIVES OF ELIJAH AND ELISHA TOKEN DEVOTION: THE REACTION 2 Kings 5:15-27 11.12.23

True devotion is no token matter

Two wonders of God's grace to behold help us take it seriously:

#1 MARVEL AT GOD'S KINDNESS: THE TRUE DEVOTION GRACE INSPIRES (14-19a)

Five ways to marvel at God's kindness:

#1 Take God seriously: The deep <u>consideration</u> grace merits: '...then he returned...' (15a) God's grace is not the end of our pursuit of him, but the beginning

#2 Take your allegiance seriously: The deep <u>conviction</u> grace secures: '...Behold, I know that there is no God in all the earth but in Israel...' (15b) God's grace is found nowhere else but in him

#3 Take God's gifts seriously: The deep <u>appreciation</u> grace deserves: '...accept now a present from your servant...but he refused...' (15c-16) God's grace is not deserved, cannot be earned, and neither can it be repaid

#4 Take change seriously: The deep <u>transformation</u> grace begins: '...your servant...' (17-18) God's grace never leaves someone unchanged

#5 Don't take yourself too seriously: The deep <u>recognition</u> grace clarifies: '...Go in peace...' (19a) God's grace will sustain us through the many complexities of life

#2 TREMBLE AT GOD'S SEVERITY: THE <u>TOKEN 'DEVOTION'</u> GRACE EXPOSES (19b-27)

Three commitments of those who tremble at God's severity:

#1 Refuse to compare yourself on human standards with others: The <u>offense</u> we can release (19b-20a) God's grace is for God to decide

#2 Kill sin early before it matures: The <u>evil</u> we can repent of (20b-25) God's grace can keep us from sin early on

#3 Count the costs: The judgment it incurs we can learn to escape (26-27) God's grace is more necessary than we think
