KNOW THE PREDICTION: NO JOKE

2 Pet 3:1-3 4.28.24

Christ's return will come to some as a long-awaited comfort and to others as a shocking terror; but one thing it will never remain to anyone is just a joke

Four readiness measures to help you take Christ's return seriously:

#1 **DIG INTO GOD'S WORD**: THE SURE *SCRIPTURES* WE CAN EARNESTLY RECEIVE (1A)

Six relevant elements involved in rightly receiving the Scriptures:

- #1 Their Historical Context: Trust how they come temporally '... This is now....' (1a1)
- #2 Their Theological Sequence: Trust how they come progressively '...the second....' (1a²)
- #3 Their Textual <u>Substance</u>: Trust how they come palpably '...letter' (1a³)
- #4 Their Authorial Purpose: Trust how they come purposefully '...that I am writing' (1a4)
- #5 Their Original Audience: Trust how they come particularly '...to you....' (1a5)
- #6 Their Relational Significance: Trust how they come personally '...beloved' (1a6)

#2 TAKE NOTE OF GOD'S WISDOM: THE KEEN REMINDERS WE CAN CAREFULLY PONDER (1B)

Four qualities of God's wisdom to ponder:

- #1 His Continuity: God doesn't change '...In both of them' (1b1)
- #2 His <u>Intentionality</u>: God knows we do change and that we need help not to settle into complacency '...I am stirring up' (1b²)
- #3 His <u>Dignity</u>: Even so, God knows that his followers still do genuinely care '...your sincere mind' ($1b^3$)
- #4 **His <u>Consistency</u>**: So God will keep reminding us as long until we don't need it anymore '...by way of reminder....' (1b⁴-2a¹)

#3 **GIVE HEED TO GOD'S <u>WITNESSES</u>**: THE BOLD *MESSENGERS* WE CAN RESPECTFULLY AFFIRM (2)

Two aspects of authority we can affirm:

#1 Affirm His Clear Messages: Heed the authoritative nature in which God speaks (2a², 2b¹)

Two clear examples of the authoritative nature of his messages to affirm:

- #1 **His Bold <u>Predictions</u>**: Heed the providential authority God claims '...that you should remember the predictions' (2a²)
- #2 His Bold <u>Commandment</u>: Heed the *moral* authority God claims '...and the commandment' (2b¹)
- #2 Affirm His Chosen Messengers: Heed the authoritative sources though which God chose to speak (2a³, 2b²)

Two chosen sources as authoritative messengers to affirm:

- #1 **His Chosen <u>Prophets</u>**: Heed the *prophetic* messengers to whom God gave authority '...of the holy prophets' (2a³)
- #2 His Chosen Apostles: Heed the apostolic messengers to whom God gave authority '... of the Lord and Savior through your apostles' (2b²)

#4 HOLD ON IN GOD'S WAITING: THE SNIDE CHALLENGERS WE CAN PATIENTLY ENDURE (3)

Six ways we can biblically prepare for the challengers God expects us to patiently endure:

- #1 Knowingly: Grab hold of the prophecies God gave '...knowing this' (3a)
- #2 Confidently: Grab hold of the priority God sets '...first of all' (3b)
- #3 <u>Carefully</u>: Grab hold of the sobriety God shows '...that scoffers will come...with scoffing' (3c)
- #4 <u>Understandingly</u>: Grab hold of the *clarity* God gives '...in the last day' (3d)
- #5: <u>Solemnly</u>: Grab hold of the *difficulty* God describes '...following their own sinful desires....' (3e)
- #6 <u>Compassionately</u>: Grab hold of the empathy God expresses '...The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.....' (9)
