ONWARD 2025 – KNOW THEIR STORY SOUND CHECK: CAN YOU HEAR ME NOW? Col 4:2-6 1.26.24

To make a big impact for Christ, silence is not an option; but turning the volume up doesn't matter when you're on mute

Two essential communication outputs to keep active:

THE VERTICAL OUTPUT # 1 FIERCE <u>PRAYER</u> — TALK BOLDLY WITH GOD ABOUT PEOPLE (4:2-4) Big impacts for Christ depend upon fierce prayer

Four qualities of fierce prayer:

#1 <u>ONGOING</u> DEVOTION: PRAY CONTINUALLY — '...Continue steadfastly...' (4:2a) Fierce prayer isn't seasonal – it keeps going

#2 INTENSE VIGILANCE: PRAY TENACIOUSLY — '...being watchful in it...' (4:2b) Fierce prayer isn't easy – it takes effort and pays attention

#3 <u>MINDFUL</u> APPRECIATION: PRAY GRATEFULLY — '...with thanksgiving...' (4:2c) Fierce prayer isn't all asks – it makes time to say 'thank you'

#4 <u>DRIVEN</u> MISSION: PRAY STRATEGICALLY — '...pray also for us, that...' (4:3, 4) Fierce prayer isn't just about our personal whims – it cares for others and what matters most to God

Three strategic requests to make boldly:

#1 Pray for Gospel <u>Opportunity</u> — '...God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ...' (4:3a)

#2 Pray for Gospel <u>Bravery</u> — '...on account of which I am prison...' (4:3b)

#3 **Pray for Gospel** <u>Clarity</u> — '...that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak...' (4:4)

THE HORIZONTAL OUTPUT # 2 A WISE <u>WITNESS</u> — TALK WISELY WITH PEOPLE ABOUT GOD (4:5-6) Big impacts for Christ happen through wise witnesses

Six qualities of a wise witness:

#1 AN <u>ALL IN</u> LIFESTYLE: WITNESS *CREDIBLY* — '...walk in wisdom...' (4:5a) Wise witnesses consider their entire way of life

#2 AN <u>OUTGOING</u> MINDSET: WITNESS *PROACTIVELY* — '...toward outsiders...' (4:5b) Wise witnesses have unbelievers in mind and in their lives

#3 <u>FULL ON</u> EFFICIENCY: WITNESS OPPORTUNELY — '...making the best use of the time...' (4:5c) Wise witnesses use their time well

#4 AN <u>IN-TUNE</u> WARMTH: WITNESS TASTEFULLY — '...Let your speech be always gracious...' (4:6a) Wise witnesses weigh the impact of their speech

#5 AN <u>UP-FRONT</u> DISTINCTION: WITNESS CLEARLY — '...seasoned with salt...' (4:6b) Wise witnesses stand out enough to be noticed

#6 <u>ON POINT</u> FINESSE: WITNESS CAPABLY — '...so that you may know how you ought to answer each person...' (4:6c) Wise witnesses work hard to understand and engage with the person in front of them
