SERVANT KING | A LEADER WORTH FOLLOWING

OWNED BY JESUS: GOD'S SERVANT PRIORITIZES WORSHIP Mark 12:313-44 8.3.25

Those who play games with God find themselves owned before they even get started

Two losing tactics hypocrites grasp at in their doomed contest against reality:

#1 "I'll JUST OUTSMART GOD" – OUR 'CLEVERNESS' DOESN'T IMPRESS GOD (13-37)

Imagining our 'dilemmas' stump God is a big mistake | Abandon your schemes to outwit God

Four rounds of 'clever' confrontations show the futility of trying to outsmart God:

Round #1 On <u>Loyalty</u>: An apparent *moral* dilemma about taxes posed by a sinister alliance of the cultural influencers (13-17)

Round #2 On <u>Logic</u>: An apparent *logical* dilemma about the resurrection posed by cynical institutional elite (18-27)

Round #3 On <u>Law</u>: An apparent *practical* dilemma about the law posed by an 'opportunist' legal scholar (28-34)

Bonus Round #4 **On** <u>Lordship</u>: An apparent *theological* dilemma about the Christ posed by Jesus Himself in return (35-37)

#2 "I'll JUST OUTSHINE OTHERS" – OUR 'PERFORMANCES' DON'T IMPRESS GOD (38-44)

'Reverence' to impress eyes of men isn't real worship to the heart of God | Drop the charade

Two contrasting kinds of reverence show the vanity of trying to outdo others:

#1 Man-Oriented <u>Showmanship</u>: Fake reverence competing with people to impress others by our own 'glory' as showcased by the scribes (38-40)

#2 God-Oriented Worship: True reverence celebrating God in praise of his glory (41-44)
